LEADERSHIP STYLES – JESUS MODEL

Revelation 4: 7

This passage suggests the leadership style according to the model of Jesus Christ.

1. LION - Power, Lordship, Authority.
This is the figure of Jesus in the gospel of Matthew. Jesus comes from lineage of the king David.
2. BULL - Service - Leader Servant.
This is the figure of Jesus in the gospel of Mark. “The Son of Man came do serve....” Mark 10: 45.
